How To Use

Rate	4 oz/A. Do not apply more than two 4 oz/A applications per season
Timing	Apply to established alfalfa Winter annuals: apply in fall before target weeds emerge Spring and summer annuals: apply to dormant alfalfa (prior to green up) Summer annuals: apply between cuttings immediately after hay removal and before 3" of growth occurs
Method	Ground rig, air or chemigation
Adjuvant	Not allowed, unless applying after last cutting prior to winter dormant period
Haying/Grazing	25 days after application
REI / PHI	REI 12 hours / PHI 25 days

Other Important Information

- *Chateau* requires at least ¼" of irrigation or rainfall for activation.
- *Chateau* may burn alfalfa leaves and stems. Users should understand and accept this risk.
- *Chateau* is a preemergence herbicide and will not control emerged weeds. Must tank mix to provide burndown.
