APPLICATION INFORMATION

Treaty Extra can be tank-mixed with grass herbicide such as Everest®, Discover® or Puma® and other broadleaf herbicides such as Maestro® MA, 2,4-D or MCP (amine or ester) for weed control in wheat, barley and/or triticale.

APPLICATION TIMING AND RATES

Rate: 0.3 to 0.6 oz per acre

Timing to weeds: Apply to select weeds from germination to less than 4 inches in height.

Wheat, barley, winter oat and triticale: Apply after the crop is in the 2-leaf stage, but before the flag leaf is visible.

Spring oat: Make applications after the crop is in the 3-leaf stage, but before jointing.

Pre-plant burndown: Apply at least 45 days before planting corn, cotton, rice, grain sorghum or soybeans. Annual broadleaf weeds should be past the cotyledon stage and actively growing, but less than 4 inches tall or across.
