



HARASS® Herbicide—Effective postemergent control of broadleaf weeds

HARASS® Herbicide controls more than 40 broadleaf weeds in wheat, barley, triticale and fallow. **HARASS** contains the active ingredient thifensulfuron, and provides reliable postemergent control of weeds such as wild mustard, curly dock and field pennycress.

As a cost-effective alternative to Harmony® herbicide, **HARASS** also has a low use rate and can be tank-mixed with other suitable grass herbicides to control additional weeds. For application convenience, **HARASS** can be tank-mixed with fungicides and insecticides registered for use on cereal crops. Check label for specific crops and use rates.

HARASS may also be used for post-harvest and preplant burndown programs. It is absorbed through the foliage of labeled weeds, rapidly inhibiting their growth. Leaves of susceptible plants appear yellow or white in one to three weeks after application (three to five weeks for wild garlic).

Application Information

For best results, apply **HARASS** during the spring, summer and fall when the majority of weeds have emerged and are growing. Review label for directions on applying in fallow, on cereal crops and for pre-plant burndown. The degree and duration of control of weeds may depend on the following factors:

- Weed spectrum and infestation intensity
- Weed size at application
- Environmental condition at and following treatment



Consult label for specific direction on spray additives, re-entry interval (REI) and personal protective equipment (PPE).
