RHYTHM® Herbicide provides outstanding postemergence control of more than 50 broadleaf weeds including: Palmer amaranth, waterhemp, giant ragweed and morningglory. RHYTHM, with the active ingredient fomesafen, is tough on weeds, but gentle on soybeans. A selective herbicide, it is an excellent and affordable alternative to Flexstar® herbicide.

RHYTHM acts quickly, does not translocate, and has both foliar and soil activity. It's also a great tank-mix product. RHYTHM can be mixed with other grass and broadleaf herbicides, including Glyphos® X-TRA, for use on Roundup Ready® soybeans to control additional weeds.

Application Timing

The best timing for broad spectrum postemergence control of susceptible broadleaf weeds is obtained when **RHYTHM** is applied early to actively growing weeds. This is usually 14-28 days after planting. Refer to weed tables on the **RHYTHM Herbicide** label for specific recommendations on weed growth stages, rates and regions. **RHYTHM** should be applied at a minimum spray volume of 15-gallons of water per acre.



Emerged weeds must be thoroughly covered with spray and optimum control is achieved by postemergent applications of **RHYTHM** to growing broadleaf weeds that are not under stress from moisture, temperature and low soil fertility, or from mechanical or chemical injury. Some bronzing, crinkling or spotting of soybean leaves may occur following applications, but soybeans will grow out of these effects and develop normally.

Growers in Regions 1, 2, 3 and 4 may also apply **RHYTHM** at preplant for preemergence control and suppression of target weeds in soybeans.

Consult label for specific direction on spray additives, re-entry interval (REI) and personal protective equipment (PPE).
