## Count on DuPont for blazing weed control



### DuPont™ Prequel® herbicide, applied as a burndown or preemergence treatment in corn delivers:

- Burndown plus residual control of winter annuals, early spring grasses and broadleaf weeds, including marestail and woolly cupgrass, even under cool, wet conditions.
- Two modes of action to improve control of glyphosate or ALS-tolerant/resistant weeds.
- Easy mixing dry formulation, no liquid bulk pumps, tanks or meters needed.
- Ideal set-up treatment in glyphosate-tolerant corn when followed by Abundit® Extra (glyphosate) plus DuPont™ Realm™ Q or Resolve® Q herbicides.

### Rate recommendation

DuPont™ Prequel® 1.66 oz/A (40 acres per bottle).  
For fine soils, a rate of up to 2.5 oz/A can be used.

For burndown, the addition of a non-ionic surfactant or crop oil concentrate and ammonium nitrogen fertilizer is recommended.

### Application information

- Add in a DuPont™ Cinch® or Breakfree® brand product for additional control from your preemergence program.
- Can be followed postemergence with DuPont™ Steadfast® Q, Realm™ Q or Resolve® Q herbicides with appropriate tank-mix partners.
- Prequel® may be applied up to 30 days prior to planting, on soil surface, or uniformly incorporated in the top two inches of soil before planting.
