



## **NUANCE®** Herbicide—Preplant and post-harvest burndown plus effective postemergent control of broadleaf weeds

**Nuance® Herbicide** controls numerous broadleaf weeds in wheat, barley, triticale and fallow. A postemergent herbicide, **NUANCE** may also be used for post-harvest and preplant burndown programs. It contains the active ingredient tribenuron and is an inexpensive alternative to Express® herbicide providing outstanding control of weeds such as common purslane, lambsquarters and field pennycress.

For additional flexibility, **NUANCE** may be mixed with other registered herbicides including 2,4-D and MCP for resistance management and expanded weed spectrum control programs. Please refer to the product label for specific crops and use rates.

**NUANCE** is absorbed through the foliage of labeled weeds, rapidly inhibiting their growth. Leaves of susceptible plants appear yellow or white from one to three weeks after application.

## **Application Information**

For best results, apply **NUANCE** after the crop is in the 2-leaf stage, but before the flag leaf is visible. For fallow and postemergent burndown, apply the product to weeds up to 3 inches in height. For post-harvest burndown, apply **NUANCE** to crop stubble, please see the application timing section of the label for restrictions on planting intervals. The degree and duration of control of weeds may depend on the following factors:

- Weed spectrum and infestation intensity
- Weed size at application
- Environmental condition at and following treatment



Consult label for specific direction on spray additives, re-entry interval (REI) and personal protective equipment (PPE).
