Here's how it works

Finesse® lets you start early to control broadleaf weeds and suppress pigeongrass with one application. There is no need for a separate trip later when all the weeds have emerged. The dual control of Finesse® — both postemergence and residual — lets you start earlier than most other herbicide treatments.

Mixing: When applying Finesse®, just add it directly to water, then add any tank-mix herbicides. Use a surfactant, because it increases the activity on weeds while being gentle to your wheat or barley crop. When tank mixing other products with Finesse®, follow the most restrictive label.

Preplant and preemergence application — winter and spring wheat only

Rates: Use 0.3 ounce per acre in Wyoming, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota and Minnesota.

Postemergence application — wheat and barley

Rates: Use 0.2 to 0.4 ounce per acre, depending on the types of broadleaf weeds that you have.

Use 0.3 to 0.4 ounce per acre for suppression of green foxtail (pigeongrass).

Timing: Apply anytime the crop is in the 1-leaf stage, but before boot stage.
